Throughout his business career Buzz served on several community-service boards including Lions Club International and six years as a Board Member of the Lake George Association. He currently is a member of the LGA's Emeritus Board and volunteers as a Captain on the LGA Floating Classroom.

He is a second-term member of the Board of Directors of the Lake George Land Conservancy, a founding member of their Apperson Society and the Henry G. Rowan Conservation Award recipient in 2007. He is also Vice President of the Gold Coast Jazz Society in Fort Lauderdale, Florida and is a senior correspondent for the **Lake George Mirror**, the oldest summer newspaper in the country.
