Double H Ranch Announces Renovation of Deer Camper Cabin through support of Christopher Dailey Foundation

Lake Luzerne, NY – June 1, 2012 – The Double H Ranch announces that through a generous financial donation from the Christopher Dailey Foundation the Deer Camper Cabin has been renovated in advance of the Summer 2012 season. Funding from this grant totaling \$55,000 was awarded for the renovation of a camper cabin as well as funding campers from Saratoga County to attend the Double H Summer Residential Program.

The Double H Ranch will hold a ribbon cutting ceremony on Thursday June 14, 2012 at 4:30-5:30 pm to celebrate the opening of the renovated cabin. Board members from the Double H Ranch, Christopher Dailey Foundation and media are invited to attend a special unveiling of the cabin. Renovations include a new interior, central air conditioning, four handicap accessible bathrooms, and new plumbing and electrical systems. The Deer Cabin houses up to nine campers age 6-8 years old. This summer marks the Double H Ranch's 20th year of Making Dreams a Reality, FREE of charge, for children and their families dealing with a life-threatening illness.
